A typical scam includes a phone call from someone claiming to work for Microsoft or Apple tech support stating that your computer is infected with a virus. The fraudster will then request access to the computer to remove the virus. In some scenarios, the fraudster has asked for sensitive personal information such as account number, social security number, etc., to steal your identity.

Mobile Wallets

Mobile Wallets allow you to add your Trax debit/credit card to your mobile wallet, which means you can pay without swiping or inserting your card!

Our cards can be added to Apple Pay, Android Pay, and Samsung Pay! Simply open the app on your phone, select your Trax card, and hold your mobile device near the payment terminal!

Your actual card number is never shared with the terminal, instead, the Mobile Wallet creates a random series of numbers, called a Token, to transmit payment.

This means Mobile Wallets are a safe, secure payment option!
